5. In any class, judges reserve the right to withhold any or all awards if not merited.
6. Exhibits may not be removed before 9:30 PM Friday and must be removed by 8 AM Saturday.
7. Exhibits will be divided into four divisions based on the age of the exhibitor:
Div. 1 – Ages 8-10 • Div. 2 – age 11-13 • Div. 3 – age 14 – 18 • Div. 4 – age 19 & over

1. **Persons engaged in photography, as a business will not be eligible to exhibit.**
2. Photos must be matted and mounted on a sturdy backer board with a securely fastened wire (preferred) or string.
3. If framed with glass, frame must use D Rings and stainless steel picture wire.
A. No string with tape, hook, paperclips, etc.
4. Matts or frames must be between 5" x 7" and 16" x 20" (no larger).

RULES

1. Only one entry per exhibitor per class.
2. Entries, exclusive of any framing, may not exceed 36" in any direction.
3. Artwork will be displayed on pegboards using pegboard hooks as hanging devices. The art **MUST** be mounted with firm backing and/or framed **AND ADEQUATELY EQUIPPED with cord or wire on the back of each entry** so that it can be hung securely, and fair patrons can view it safely. Sawtooth hangers are not recommended. The hanging capabilities of each piece will be checked by committee members.
4. Every effort will be made to prevent damage to the artwork, but the committee assumes no responsibility for work that falls due to insufficient mounting.
5. Artwork should be appropriate for viewing in a public arena by all age groups.
6. Judging will be done based upon style and execution of each entry:
 - A. Were the principles of composition effectively utilized? (Emphasis, balance, variety, proportion, movement, harmony)
 - B. Were the materials from each designated medium handled with skill?
7. Exhibition Classifications:
 - A. Pencil Drawing - Graphite Only
 - B. Colored Pencil Drawing
 - C. Pen & Ink
 - D. Crayon/Marker
 - E. Charcoal
 - F. Pastel/Oil Pastel
 - G. Watercolor
 - H. Tempera Paint
 - I. Acrylic Paints
 - J. Oil Paints
 - K. Mixed Media/Collage
 - L. Printmaking
 - M. Digital Art

One 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize will be awarded in each class of each division. See Rule #5 under Dept. 19.

8. ONE Best of Show Ribbon will be awarded in each of the four divisions, which will include a \$10.00 premium.
9. There will be a display table for all children under 8 years old to show one work of their choice. The works will not be judged for prizes, but will be given a ribbon of display. This will give children an opportunity to gain experience showing their work.
