RULES

1. **ALL ARTICLES MUST BE PREPARED BY THE EXHIBITOR.** No premiums for Commercial products. (Examples: No cake, brownie, cookie or pie crust mixes to be used.)
2. Entries will be accepted between noon and 9 PM Tuesday.
3. Each of the classes shall also be open to exhibitors from age 8 through and including 18 years of age, with separate equal premiums to be awarded these entrants. Participant ribbons will be awarded to exhibitors age 7 and under. Exceptions are the following classes: The PA's Incredible! Angel Food Cake Contest, the Homemade Chocolate Cake Contest, and the Blue Ribbon Apple Pie Contest. Exhibitors ages 8 through and including 18 will compete with adults in these classes.

4. **The Baked Products section is unable to accept any entries that require refrigeration due to the delay between entry day and judging. This includes cream cheese frostings and fillings.**
5. Please use a plastic bag or disposable plastic container to preserve the freshness and appearance of your baked product entry when possible.
6. Recipes that are required to accompany entries in special contests should be typed or neatly printed on one side of an 8 1/2" x 11" size paper and include ingredients and instructions.
7. All entries in the Baked Products Section, except those portions kept for exhibit, will be on sale in the Hoffman Community Building immediately after the judging Wednesday afternoon. The Quarryville Fire Company Special Division will be in charge of the sale and proceeds.
8. Baked Goods to be judged on:
 - A. General appearance (size, shape, uniformity of pieces, crust and color)
 - B. Sensory qualities (aroma, flavor, moistness/consistency and texture)
 - C. Decorated cakes and cupcakes will be judged on appearance only.
9. **Best of Show:** Two \$25 cash awards, sponsored by Maplehofe Dairy, will be awarded to the best of show entries in the adult classes. Two additional \$25 cash awards, also sponsored by Maplehofe Dairy will be awarded to the best of show entries in the Youth or 4H classes.
10. **All baked product entries are to remain on display until 9:30 PM Friday evening. After 9:30 PM, entries can be released to the exhibitor and are to be removed no later than 8 AM on Saturday morning. STRONGLY SUGGEST coming Friday evening if you would like your ribbon and/or entry.**

Entries may not be removed before 9:30 PM Friday. The Fair Management is not responsible for spoilage of any canned or cured products during the exhibition.

RULES

1. To ensure a uniform exhibit, Section 2 entries must be in a clear standard pint or quart canning jar. Section 3 entries must be 1/4 lb. bagged entires. Section 4 entries must be in a standard jelly jar.
2. All jars must have standard two-piece canning lid and ring free from rust. Any unsealed jars, except dried products, will be disqualified. All products should be processed according to manufacturer recommendations.
3. Each exhibitor must have canned or prepared the article exhibited since last year's fair.
4. Each of the classes shall also be open to exhibitors under 19 years of age, with separate equal premiums to be awarded these entrants.
5. Exhibitors may enter in as many classes or subdivisions of classes as they wish, but shall not make more than one entry of same subdivision, nor can they win more than one prize of the same subdivision.
6. Items that are not listed in a class will not be judged. Judges have the option of opening and tasting any item.
7. Exhibits will be judged as follows:
 - A. Sections 2 & 3

General Appearance.....	40
Quality.....	50
Container.....	10
	100

General Appearance – All products shall be properly cleaned, and if pared, all skins should be removed. All pieces should be uniform in size. If cut, have edges clean and even. Food should have as natural color as possible. Arrange food neatly but do not pack too loose or too tight. Product should be canned at the right stage, such as snap beans free from strings and large beans, tomatoes of a good red color, corn that is young and tender, carrots and beets that are small, young and tender, and fruits that are not overripe.

Quality – Liquid clear and free of small pieces, no discoloration or gas bubble due to decomposition. Product should have retained its shape, have a good color, and free of blemishes and bruises.

Container – Clean Container, suitably sealed.

Section 4 exhibits judged on flavor, texture, appearance and color. The judge has the option of opening and tasting any item entered.
