4. All entries must be grown by exhibitor except in arrangement classes.
5. Exhibits may be entered Tuesday from noon – 9 PM.
6. No exhibits may be removed before 9:30 PM Friday evening but must be removed by 8 AM Saturday.
7. No commercial exhibits will be accepted for competition.
8. No exhibitor may enter more than one exhibit for competition in any division of a class.
9. All youth under 19 years of age refer to Department 10, Section A-17 of Department 11, Section B-17.
10. Best of Show to be awarded - \$5.00
