RULES

1. All rabbits are to be judged according to the latest standard of perfection of the American Rabbit Breeders Association.
2. ENTRY:
 - A. Deadline for entries is September 1, 2025. Entries should be given to the chairperson before then.
 - B. All persons should enter their rabbits on Tuesday evening between 5 and 8 PM.
3. The latest rules of the American Rabbit Breeders Association will govern.
4. Classes (one rabbit per class)
 1. Junior Doe – under 6 pounds
 2. Senior Doe – 6 pounds and over
 3. Junior Buck – under 6 pounds
 4. Senior Buck – 6 pounds and over
 5. Meat Pen – (3 rabbits, each between 3 1/2-5 1/2 pounds)
5. No Does with litters will be permitted to be shown.
6. Meat Pens
 - A. Must be exhibited by youth and may be sold at the Livestock Sale on Friday evening. Rabbits to be sold must be designated at the time of entry.
 - B. Must have been bred 100 days prior to show day.
 - C. Farm checks must be conducted 1-2 weeks after birth.

Department 10 – 4-H AND VOCATIONAL

ELIGIBILITY

4-H Club Members must have passed their eighth birthday but not have passed their nineteenth birthday by January 1, of the year of the fair. Exhibitors must be members of a regularly organized 4-H Club, carrying a project in the field they wish to make and be under the supervision of the Pennsylvania State University Agricultural and Home Economics Extension Service by July 1 preceding the fair. Exhibits must have been selected through an elimination.

Students enrolled in an accepted vocational school curriculum must be conducting a project in the class in which they wish to make an entry. Students enrolled in general home economics in a comprehensive high school are considered as qualifying. All entries shall be approved prior to the fair by a member of the Pennsylvania Department of Education, Agriculture or Home Economics staff or their designated representative.
